## BUILDING STRONG COMMUNITIES

**Northern Medical Clinics program** through the **March of Dimes** provides supporting health care for individuals in rural communities. Funding will support existing clinics, expanding the program and offering care as demands rise in the North.

Nine people with disabilities and developmental conditions from Moosonee will be able to travel to for community participation activities through funding **James Bay Association for Community Living**.

**Iroquois Falls Access Transit Bus/Transport Adapté** is the only wheelchair accessible bus service in town to an aging population. Funding for the bus will be used for fuel, maintenance, and upkeep of the service.

**Bibliotheque Publique d'Iroquois Falls Public Library** will purchase a new chair for the library and new large print books to promote the community and comfort in their library.

**Chapleau General Hospital Foundation** funding will help purchase a bladder volume instrument to assist medical staff in beside testing and the placement of catheters when a patient's condition is too precarious for formal diagnostic testing. The hospital is the sole provider of acute and palliative care to the surrounding communities.

## POVERTY TO POSSIBILITY

**Partners for Employment Centre, Vitality Kit program**, helps people move out of poverty, contributes towards helping them meet their basic needs (food, clothing and personal care products), and assists an individual with maintaining their employment

**March of Dimes Canada, Assistive Devices Program**, works to ensure that persons with disabilities who are in financial need have access to the essential assistive devices that they require to maintain and/or improve their mobility and functional independence.
