



# COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX PROGRAM 2019

Income tax returns completed by trained volunteers for individuals and families who qualify:

Family Size	Total Family Income
1 person	\$35,000
2 persons	\$45,000
3 persons	\$47,500
4 persons	\$50,000
5 persons	\$52,500
More than 5 persons	\$52,500 + \$2,500 for each additional person

- Clients should bring all their slips and if available, the Notice of Assessment from the previous tax year.
- Deceased persons (estates) cannot be completed.
- Clients who wish to file for a relative require documentation of Power of Attorney.
- Clients can file for 2018 and 2017 anytime. Clients who have 3 or more years to complete will have attend a separate clinic.

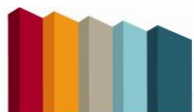
